- 1. This form must be used by any parent / carer / guardian wishing to apply for their son/daughter to be admitted to the academy.
- 2. You may be asked for evidence of the son/daughter's date of birth.
- 3. The student's permanent address is where he or she normally lives and sleeps and goes to school from. Should we be able to offer a place proof of residence will be required. You will be asked to provide your original Council Tax or Child Benefit documents. If false or misleading information is used to gain entry to the academy the offer of a place will be withdrawn and the application cancelled.
- 4. The term "sibling" means a full, step, half, adopted or fostered brother or sister but **not cousins**. The academy reserves the right to ask for proof of relationship.
- 5. Admissions Criteria Places will be offered from our waiting list in strict order according to our Admissions criteria. These being:
 - Children in the care of the council ("Looked after" children)
 - Siblings of students currently attending the academy who will continue to do son on the date of admission.
 - Special medical needs, social needs and special needs.
 - Nearest straight line distance to the academy. The distance is measured using software to determine the straight-line distance between the student's permanent address and the designated entrance to the academy main building. Where parental responsibility is shared, the address of the parent / guardian who receives the child benefit allowance for the child will be taken as the permanent address.

In Year Admissions - The Academy may refuse any request for a transfer on the grounds set out in our own Admissions Policy and the Schools Admission Code.

As part of the admissions process, we will ask for background information from your child's previous school. This will consist of attendance information for the current school year, their latest academic report and any exclusions information.

We use this data to determine what level of support we would need to offer your child and whether this can be reasonably met.
